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

This is in response to a number of procedural matters in connection with the above captioned proceeding:



Conner, Jr., dated May 27, 1969, requesting additional data relating to calculations of thyroid dose, the New York State Atomic Energy Council has no objection to such request or to Mr. Conner's reply thereto, dated June 6, 1969. The New York State Atomic Energy Council does not request oral argument on the positions asserted by the parties.
- (2) In response to the Board's letter to Troy B. Upton and Leonard Trosten, dated May 23, 1969, the New York State Atomic Energy

- (3) The New York State Atomic Energy Council has no objection to the proposed findings and conclusions contained in "AEC Regulatory Staff's Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law (In the Form of a Proposed Initial Decision)", submitted by Mr. Conner's letter to the Board, dated June 6, 1969, as corrected by Mr. Conner's letter to the Board, dated June 9, 1969, and Mr. Newman's letter to the Board, dated June 13, 1969.
