Dear Mr. Jensch:

In my letter of April 23, 1969, I informed you that my client, Citizens Committee for the Protection of the Environment, although not withdrawing as an intervenor in the above proceeding, would not participate in the hearing upon its resumption on April 28. At the time I wrote you, it was my understanding that my client would not participate in the hearing last week in any form, shape, or manner. I had no communication with Mr. Bogart or any other representative or official of the Citizens Committee subsequent to writing you on April 23 and through the week of April 27. I was, therefore, most surprised and concerned to read last Thursday in Nucleonics Week that my client was apparently participating in the hearing.

I am certain that Mr. Bogart's participation in the hearing last week was based on his misunderstanding of the situation and on his failure to realize fully the implications of his action. Nevertheless, I feel that I have no alternative at this point but to withdraw as counsel for the Citizens Committee, and by this letter I so withdraw.
