Gentlemen:

By a letter dated April 8, 1969, you requested the staff, in an effort to expedite the proceeding, to submit written answers to the questions propounded both at the prehearing conference and at the evidentiary hearing held on March 25 - 27. Enclosed find the staff's answers.

Appendix A contains the answers to the questions, except for those peculiarly within the applicant's knowledge, raised by the board at the prehearing conference. It also contains comments on matters raised at the evidentiary hearing by the board and in limited appearances. Appendix B contains our comments on the testimony of James Halitsky and on some of the board's questions concerning it. We proposed to offer Appendices A and B in evidence.

We have also included an Appendix C to respond to questions raised during limited appearances which may not have been answered at the evidentiary hearing. These answers are not considered as evidence in the proceeding. We have, however, included them with the other documents for the information of the public.
