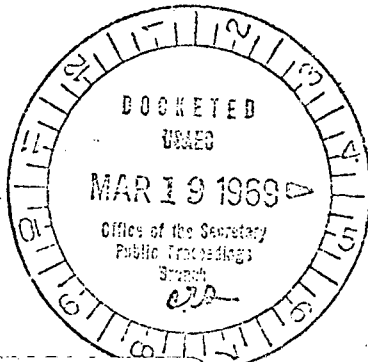
As Superintendent of Recreation for the Town of Mamaroneck I wish to express my support in the matter of granting a permit to construct a third nuclear generating station at Indian Point by Con Edison.

Having investigated fully all of the claims that the granting of this permit will be detrimental to the residents of Westchester County, especially in the immediate area of the plant, and weighing them against the overwhelming evidence of the many benefits that will be derived in the way of increased power, decreased air pollution and the additional taxes that will accrue to the ever growing numbers of residents of Westchester County, I feel that this added plant can only be considered a necessity.

Besides the above mentioned direct results of the plant, I see the ancillary benefits of increased recreation facilities in the immediate vicinity of the plant and expanded educational facilities at the plant. Another added feature will be the impact upon the economy of Westchester County during the construction period.

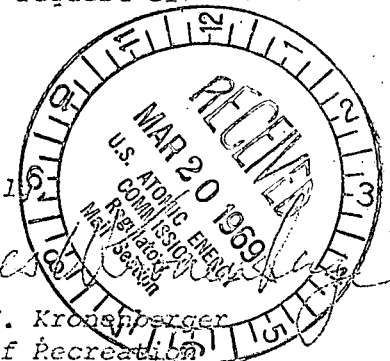
For the above reasons I respectfully submit that the request of Con Edison for a permit be granted.
