Reference is made to your letter dated October 26, 1971. Regarding your request contained in paragraph 1, the material referenced is quite voluminous. The charge for reproduction would be \$.25 per page for textial material payable in advance. It is estimated such reproduction would cost approximately \$1,500.00 and take months to prepare. This would apply to Indian Point, Units 1, 2 and 3. No material of the type your request has been issued or received for Units 4 and 5.

For Units 2 and 3, the material has been placed in the library at the Hendrick Hudson High School at Montrose, New York; these you may read there.
