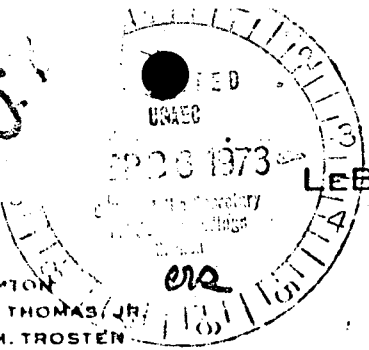

Dear Sirs:

On August 17, 1973, the Board entered as its order the Special Prehearing Conference Order agreed upon by the parties. Said order recites, in paragraph 3, that the parties shall exchange interrogatories or requests for documents during September 1973. That time was agreed upon because of the Regulatory Staff's estimate that the Draft Environmental Statement would be made available on or about September 5, 1973.

I am now advised by Mr. Karman that the Staff hopes to publish the DES by October 1. Obviously, the predicate for requiring interrogatories and requests for documents to be exchanged in September is no longer valid. The parties have therefore stipulated and agreed that the time for exchanging interrogatories or requests for documents set forth in paragraph 3 of the aforesaid order shall be extended until 30 days after the publication of the DES.
