Dear Mr. Robinson:

Reference is made to your letter dated May 10, 1973 wherein you propose four areas for an agreement among the parties, which agreement would then be presented to the Board at the prehearing conference in the above captioned proceeding to be held at Croton-on-Hudson May 21, 1973.

The regulatory staff is in general agreement with your proposals. We do however, recommend certain additions or modifications to them.

Proposal (a) - The regulatory staff agrees to stipulate that the entire record as to environmental questions in the AEC Docket No. 50-247 be incorporated by reference in the record of AEC Docket No. 50-286. For the convenience of the Board, the pertinent pages of the record should be specified.

Proposal (b) - The regulatory staff has no objection to this proposal. We, of course, reserve our rights to propound interrogatories at appropriate times to any of the parties.

Proposal (c) - The regulatory staff has no objection to this proposal.
