

Reference is made to your letter to the parties, dated August 7, 1974, Mr. Voigt's letter to you, dated September 12, 1974, your letter to Mr. Voigt, dated September 30, 1974, and Mr. Voigt's letter to you, dated October 3, 1974.

The AEC Regulatory Staff agrees with Mr. Voigt's suggestion in his letter of October 3, 1974. In view of the possibility of settlement of this proceeding, it may be appropriate to defer holding a prehearing conference during the month of October. However, once the status of settlement is known, the Staff agrees with the Chairman that a prehearing conference should be held to discuss the matters raised in the Chairman's letters dated August 7, 1974, and September 30, 1974.
