Dear Judge Levy:

I have been advised by John Gossel, Esq., Commission Staff Counsel, that you have requested that Dr. Arsev H. Eraslan, an Atomic Energy Commission consultant working on the Indian Point Unit No. 3 project, appear at the remand hearings regarding the above-captioned projects. It is my understanding that Dr. Eraslan has been requested to appear at the remand hearing regarding his testimony before the House Committee on Merchant Marine and Fisheries on February 19, 1974. Dr. Eraslan will be available to testify on this subject during the morning of October 24, 1974.

As I have advised Mr. Gossel in my letter to him, dated October 7, 1974, (attached), Dr. Eraslan will not have completed his work on the Indian Point Unit No. 3 Final Environmental Statement until December 15, 1974. Therefore, while Dr. Eraslan can address the subject of his prior testimony before the House Committee on Merchant Marine and Fisheries on October 24, 1974, his work on the Indian Point Unit No. 3 Final Environmental Statement will not have progressed sufficiently so as to enable him to address that subject on October 24, 1974.
