Reference is made to your letter, undated, to Dr. Arsey Eraslan and to our discussion on September 30, 1974, at the Task Force Meeting regarding Project No. 2338. Dr. Eraslan does not anticipate that his work on the Indian Point 3 Final Environmental Statement will be completed prior to December 15, 1974. As you know, this work not only includes input for the Final Environmental Statement but also includes documentation of his modeling studies regarding the Hudson River.

Subsequent to the completion of Dr. Eraslan's work on Indian Point 3, the Atomic Energy Commission would have no objection to Dr. Eraslan's participation in the remand hearings on Project No. 2338, should he be so requested.
