


AEC REGULATORY STAFF MOTION FOR LEAVE TO

On June 10, 1974, the United States Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit rendered a decision in Union of Concerned Scientists v. Atomic Energy Commission et.al., Civil Action No. 73-1099. (D.C. Cir., June 10, 1974) Slip. Op. Upon review the regulatory staff believes certain of the holdings in that decision have a bearing on the questions relating to the role of Atomic Safety and Licensing Boards and Atomic Safety and Licensing Appeal Boards with respect to treatment of uncontested matters in operating license proceedings, posed by the Commission in its letter to the parties in the captioned proceeding dated April 12, 1974.


