MOTION OF NEW YORK STATE ATOMIC
ENERGY COUNCIL FOR EXTENSION OF
TIME TO FILE EXCEPTIONS AND SUPPORTING BRIEFS

Section 2.711(a) of the Rules of Practice permits this Board upon a showing of good cause to authorize an extension of time for the performance of any act. The New York State Atomic Energy Council (Council) hereby moves for an order under 10 CFR 2.711(a) extending the time to file exceptions to the June 5, 1975 Memorandum and Order of the Licensing Board below. The State requests that its time for filing such brief be extended to July 18, 1975.

The Council presently has only one full-time attorney available to appear on its behalf at all Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC) proceedings. There are presently four major licensing proceedings ongoing in New York State. In addition, the New York State Legislature is in the final throws of adjournment and the Council's attorney is heavily committed to analyze and comment upon various legislative proposals which would make major revisions to New York State's energy related programs. With his present workload, this attorney is simply unable to obtain the necessary input from Council members so as to be able to meet a July 5, 1975 filing date.

Further, the granting of this extension will not adversely affect the licensing action in this proceeding and does not prejudice the rights of any of the other parties.

For the foregoing reasons, the State believes that good cause exists for granting this extension of time.
