IP-3 has improved sufficiently to obviate any need for meeting
with Con Ed management as was previously being considered. We
will continue to monitor this area as is appropriate during
future inspection visits.

The report speaks to the outstanding deficiencies identified
in Con Ed's records of same. Con Ed's route to resolution of
these items appears adequate.

Cladding will be added to the reactor pressure vessel nozzles
and safe ends.
