This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Fasano of this office on September 19-21, 28, 1973 of activities authorized under AEC License No. CPPR-62 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Fasano of this office, with Mr. Perry, Mr. Whittier and Mr. Hartsfield on September 28, 1973.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the Regulatory Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures, and representative records, interviews with plant personnel and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection no violations or safety items were observed.
