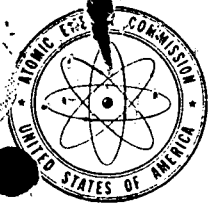

Gentlemen:

This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Fasano of this office on July 23-27, 1973 of activities authorized under AEC License No. CPPR-62 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Fasano of this office, with Mr. Kohler and his staff on July 27, 1973.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the Regulatory Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with plant personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection no violations or safety items were observed.

In accordance with Section 2.790 of the AEC's "Rules of Practice", Part 2, Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, a copy of this letter and the enclosed inspection report will be placed in the AEC's Public Document Room. If this report contains any information that you (or your contractor) believe to be proprietary, it is necessary that you make a written application within 20 days to this office to withhold such information from public disclosure.
