Gentlemen:

This refers to the meeting held at the Consolidated Edison Company corporate offices, New York, New York, on February 6, 1973. This meeting, attended by Messrs. Brunner, Allentuck, and Fasano of my staff, and management representatives from Consolidated Edison Company, concerning outstanding construction items and the pre-operational and startup test phase for Indian Point Unit 3. This also refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Rebelowski and Mr. Fasano of this office on February 22 - 23, 1973, of activities authorized by AEC Construction Permit No. CPER-62, and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Fasano with Mr. W. R. Cohen and other members of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.


The areas examined during the inspection were as shown: current construction status, RO policies for inspection during the test and startup phase to full power operation phase; and draft procedures pertaining to the flushing program. Within the scope of this inspection, no violations or safety items were identified.
