This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. H. L. Canter of this office on October 21-23, 1975 at the Indian Point 3 Nuclear Power Station, Buchanan, New York, of activities authorized by NRC License No. CPPR-62 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Canter with Mr. A. Kohler, Jr., and others of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the Office of Inspection and Enforcement Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Our inspector also verified the steps you have taken to correct the item of noncompliance brought to your attention in our letters dated April 28, 1975 and May 28, 1975. We have no further questions regarding your action at this time.

Based on the results of this inspection, a Deficiency identified through your internal audit program and corrected prior to the end of the inspection is set forth in the enclosed inspection report. No additional information is needed for this item at this time.


