This refers to the inspection conducted by Mr. Fasano of this office on January 28, 31 and February 3, 4, 10 and 11, 1975 at the Indian Point Site, Buchanan, New York of activities authorized by AEC License No. CPPR-62 and to the discussions of our findings held by Mr. Fasano with Mr. Perry of your staff at the conclusion of the inspection.

Areas examined during this inspection are described in the Office of Inspection and Enforcement Inspection Report which is enclosed with this letter. Within these areas, the inspection consisted of selective examinations of procedures and representative records, interviews with personnel, and observations by the inspector.

Within the scope of this inspection, no items of noncompliance were observed.


