Dear Mr. Woodbury:

This is to confirm our conversation of July 9, 1974 regarding a meeting among the parties in the Indian Point proceeding to discuss the status of the staff's work in the preparation of the Final Environmental Statement for Indian Point Unit No. 3. It is planned to have a two-day meeting at Oak Ridge National Laboratory starting at 9:00 a.m. on July 30, 1974 and to continue through July 31, 1974. An agenda is enclosed which incorporates the subjects in the proposed agenda you sent to me on July 22, 1974 as well as additional subjects that we suggest should also be discussed. As we discussed, we invite full and active participation by the Consolidated Edison Company representatives and others.

In addition, we have scheduled a meeting with you and your consultants at Texas Instruments, New York University and Quirk, Lawler, Matusky to be held at the Indian Point site on August 1 and 2, for the purpose of a detailed review of your research program including data relevant to entrainment impact on young-of-the-year, thermal discharges, and plume dispersion.
