Dear Mr. Seibel:

We have received the above referenced report detailing the archaeological survey of Area E, on General Electric Corporation (GE) property in Castle Hayne.

During the course of the investigation one new archaeological site was recorded: 31NH804**. This site was identified as a late 19th to mid-20th century agricultural site, probably the remains of a farm building. It contained no identified structural remains. The artifact density was low and lacked evidence of a domestic component. Environmental Services Inc. (ESI) recommended that the site is not eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places and that no further archaeological work is needed on the site. ESI further recommended that Area E of the proposed GE expansion, as currently planned, be allowed to proceed without consideration of significant cultural resources. We concur with these recommendations.

The above comments are made pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act and the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation's Regulations for Compliance with Section 106 codified at 36 CFR Part 800.
