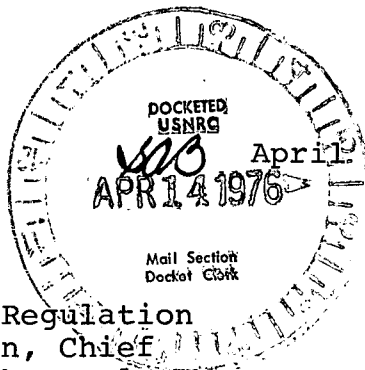

This is in reply to your letter dated March 26, 1976.

We are preparing with due diligence a complete response to your questions with respect to Con Edison's evaluation of closed-cycle cooling systems at Indian Point Unit No. 3.

All the information you requested, with the exceptions identified below, will be available by about May 14, 1976.

The information requested in Questions 9, 10, 11 and 12, which discussed details of replacing deficient energy and capacity, and system reliability, will need additional time to compile because a new analysis is required to reflect PASNY's ownership of Indian Point Unit No. 3. We are planning to submit this information to you by June 14, 1976.

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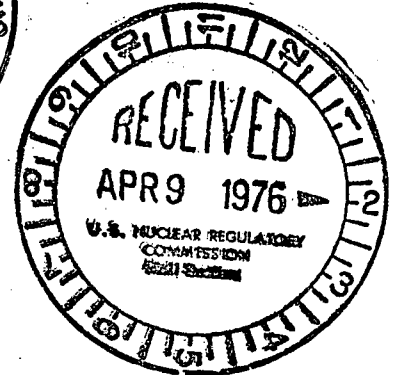
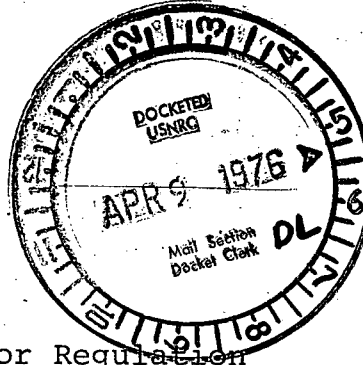


