


Dear Mr. Knighton:

It is our understanding that the Regulatory Staff is preparing to issue an interim operating license, including environmental technical specifications, for Indian Point Station, Unit No. 3. We anticipate that the environmental technical specifications will control discharges for all three plants at the Indian Point site and will, in certain cases, provide for combined limitations affecting all three plants. Accordingly, it will be appropriate for the new environmental technical specifications, when issued, to be applicable to all three plants. We hereby request that action be taken to implement this by withdrawing the existing environmental technical specifications for Indian Point Stations, Units 1 and 2, and substituting therefor the new environmental technical specifications at such time as an interim operating license for Unit No. 3 is issued.
