CM/EM Sharkey, Jeffry Jones, Bradley Beall, James Astwood, Heather Lewis, Linda Waller, Antoinette	Attached for your information is the current list of milestones and schedule projections for NRC's review of the Westinghouse applications for licenses to export up to 4 PWRs to China (XR169), along with LEU fuel for the initial cores and one reload for each of the four reactors (XSNM03034Rev). Since it is rumored that the Chinese may award the contract for these facilities in early February 2005, OIP is consulting with NSIR and the Executive Branch to identify and, if possible, pro-actively address issues that otherwise might delay or complicate completing the license reviews.
Droggitis, Spiros Coggins, Angela Thoma, John Skeen, David Kipfer, Lorna Fortune, Tojuana	The Chinese Government has not yet provided the required assurances and continues to pose probing questions about the U.S. export license review and approval process. The Department of State has been careful to explain U.S. requirements, while at the same time, trying to promote the view that the U.S. is a trustworthy trading partner. Framatome, the major competitor and incumbent foreign reactor vendor in China, is known to portray the U.S. as an unreliable supplier always imposing new groundrules. Some believe that processing the two exports as a package deal will be viewed as evidence of U.S. reliability and good faith.
