Dear Mr. Baker,

Westinghouse would like to revise the pending application (XSNM 03034) for a license to export nuclear fuel to Daya Bay Units 1&2 in China and has enclosed a revised NRC Form 7 for your consideration. Specifically, the ultimate foreign consignee needs to be changed to accommodate the Chinese Government's current needs. Since the fuel for Daya Bay will likely be supplied by Chinese companies, export license application XSNM 03034 needs to be revised to reflect our desire to supply nuclear fuel for the initial core and one reload region for each of the 4 following proposed commercial nuclear power plants. There are 2 Units at San Men and 2 Units at Yang Jiang in China. We also request that you revise the amount of uranium to be exported to ^{(b)(4)} of U235 contained in ^{(b)(4)} of uranium. Thank you for your attention to this request.
