Pursuant to the federal Freedom of Information Act and the Electronic FOIA amendments, 5 U.S.C. 552. We request copies of all:

- 1) Communication between NRC employees and representatives of Three Mile Island Nuclear Station, Unit 1, or representatives of Exelon Corp. regarding Three Mile Island Nuclear Station, Unit 1, sent or received from Nov. 21, 2009, to present.
- 2) Communication between NRC employees regarding Three Mile Island Nuclear Station, Unit 1, sent or received from Nov. 21, 2009, to present.

I request a waiver of all fees for this request. Disclosure of the requested information to me is in the public interest because it is likely to contribute significantly to public understanding of the operations or activities of the government and is not primarily in my commercial interest. This will occur through stories we may publish. The Associated Press is a not-for-profit corporation and is the collective representative of virtually all news organizations in the United States.

I am willing to pay fees for this request up to a maximum of \$20. If you estimate that the fees will exceed this limit, please inform me first by supplying me with an itemized list of charges.

As you know, the Freedom of Information Law requires that an agency respond to a request within twenty business days of receipt of a request. I look forward to a response shortly, if not as soon as possible. If for any reason any portion of my request is denied, please inform me of the reasons for the denial in writing and provide the name and address of the person or body to whom an appeal should be directed.

In the event that you determine that some portion of a file is exempt from release, I request that you release any reasonably segregable portion of the documents which is not exempt. I reserve my right to appeal such decisions.
