Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. transmits herewith three (3) signed originals and forty (40) copies of each of the documents below:

1. "Application for Amendment to Operating License," sworn to on December 28, 1979. This Application requests an amendment to the Technical Specifications to require all three auxiliary feedwater pumps to be operable prior to heating the reactor above 350°F and to limit the time that this requirement could not be met. This Application is being submitted in response to Mr. Darrell G. Eisenhut's (NRC) November 7, 1979 letter. The text of the requested modifications to the Technical Specifications and a Safety Evaluation are attached to the application papers.
2. "Application for Amendment to Operating License," sworn to on December 28, 1979. This Application requests an amendment to the Technical Specifications to limit control rod misalignment to no more than 12 steps from its control rod bank demand position. This Application is being submitted in response to Mr. A. Schwencer's (NRC) October 29, 1979 letter. The text of the requested modifications to the Technical Specifications and a Safety Evaluation are attached to the application papers.
3. "Application for Amendment to Operating License," sworn to on December 28, 1979. This Application requests an amendment to the Technical Specifications to effect certain administrative changes relative to the Station Nuclear Safety Committee (SNSC). The text of the requested modifications to the Technical Specifications and a Safety Evaluation are attached to the application papers.

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4. "Amendment No. 1 to Application for Amendment to Operating License," sworn to on December 28, 1979. This Application amends Consolidated Edison's "Application for Amendment to Operating License," forwarded to the Commission by letter dated February 9, 1979, which requested changes to the Technical Specifications to reflect redesign of the support systems of certain safety-related pipe lines. The present amended application modifies the February 9, 1979 application to reflect: (a) completion of plant modifications approved by Amendment No. 55 to Facility Operating License No. DPR-26, (b) seismic reanalyses of certain lines and (c) editorial changes. The text of the requested modifications to the Technical Specifications and a Safety Evaluation are attached to the amended application papers.

5. "Amendment No. 2 to Application for Amendment to Operating License," sworn to on December 28, 1979. This Application amends Consolidated Edison's "Application for Amendment to Operating License" and "Amendment No. 1 to Application for Amendment to Operating License," forwarded to the Commission by letters dated April 16, 1976 and January 6, 1978, respectively. The purpose of the previous applications was to propose revisions to conform the Technical Specifications to the requirements of 10CFR Part 50, Appendix J. The present amended application modifies the two previous applications to reflect technical and editorial clarifications and to update the proposed isolation valve listing. The text of the requested modifications to the Technical Specifications and a Safety Evaluation are attached to the amended application papers.

In accordance with 10CFR 170.22, Applications (1) and (2) above qualify as Class III amendments since they involve single safety issues which have been determined not to involve significant hazards considerations. Application (3) above qualifies as a Class II amendment since the changes requested are administrative in nature only. Application (4) above is amending a previous application for which the required filing fee has been paid and no additional fee is necessary. Application (5) above is amending two previous applications which were docketed prior to the effective date of the 10 CFR Part 170 regulation change and no filing fee is required.

Accordingly, as required by 10 CFR 170.22 for a Class II amendment and two (2) Class III amendments, enclosed is a check in the amount of \$9,200.00 as the total filing fee for the three applications above requiring such fees. This payment is being made under protest, and Consolidated Edison reserves the right to challenge the validity of the imposition of these fees and the basis for the determination of the amounts of the fees.


