AMENDMENT NO. 2 TO
APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT
TO OPERATING LICENSE

On April 16, 1976, Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Consolidated Edison"), as holder of Facility Operating License No. DPR-26, filed with the U.S. Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC") an "Application for Amendment to Operating License" requesting amendment of Sections 1.7, 3.6 and 4.4 of the Technical Specifications set forth in Appendix A to that license. That Application was submitted in response to Mr. Karl R. Goller's letter of August 7, 1975 in order to conform the Indian Point Unit No. 2 containment leakage testing program with the requirements of 10 CFR Part 50, Appendix J.

On January 6, 1978, Consolidated Edison filed with the NRC "Amendment No. 1 to Application for Amendment to Operating License" to effect several technical and editorial changes to the specific Technical Specification revisions proposed in the April 16, 1976 Application, to revise Section 3.3 of the Technical Specifications incorporating additional limiting conditions for operation for certain systems utilized in the containment leakage testing program, and to modify proposed

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Sections 3.6 and 4.4 reflecting the then planned addition of hardware as part of the Overpressure Protection System modification.

Consolidated Edison hereby amends its April 16, 1976 and January 6, 1978 Applications to reflect further technical and editorial clarifications and to incorporate changes in the isolation valve listings. Except as modified by the present Amended Application, the changes requested by the two previous Applications remain as originally proposed. In order to provide a complete updated package of technical specification revisions, the present proposed changes incorporate all changes requested by the previous April 16, 1976 and January 6, 1978 Applications as revised and supplemented by the present Amendment. Therefore, the specific technical specification page revisions contained in Attachment A to this Amendment supersede those revisions contained in Attachments A of the two previous Applications.

A Safety Evaluation of the proposed changes is set forth in Attachment B to this Amended Application. This evaluation demonstrates that the proposed changes do not involve a significant hazards consideration and will not cause any change in the types or an increase in the amounts of effluents or any change in the authorized power level of the facility.
