Dear Mr. Denton:

Consolidated Edison transmits herewith three (3) originals and forty (40) copies of an "Application for Amendment to Operating License", sworn to on May 21, 1980. This Application requests an amendment to the Indian Point Unit No. 2 Technical Specifications to incorporate certain changes necessary to support a planned fuel design change from HIPAR to LOPAR fuel. The specific technical specification changes requested are contained in Attachment A to the Application. A Safety Evaluation of the proposed changes is presented in Attachment B to the Application.

The planned three-phase transition to an all LOPAR fueled core will begin during the upcoming Cycle 4/5 refueling, currently scheduled to commence in January, 1981. Consistent with this schedule, the first LOPAR fuel assemblies are scheduled for delivery to the Indian Point Unit No. 2 site in early September, 1980. Therefore, we respectfully request NRC review and approval of the requested changes on or before August 22, 1980 (i.e., prior to the first fuel shipment).

Finally, in accordance with 10 CFR 170.22, this Application has been determined to be CLASS III, as it involves a single issue and has been deemed not to involve a significant hazards consideration. Therefore, as required by regulation, enclosed is a check in the amount of \$4,000.00 as the filing fee. This payment is being made under protest,


