Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Consolidated Edison") transmits herewith three (3) signed originals and forty (40) copies of a document entitled, "Amendment No. 2 to Application for Amendment to Operating License," sworn to June 19, 1980. This Application amends Consolidated Edison's "Application for Amendment to Operating License" and "Amendment No. 1 to Application for Amendment to Operating License," forwarded to the Commission by letters dated February 9, 1979 and December 31, 1979, respectively. The purpose of the previous applications was to request Technical Specification changes to reflect redesign of the support systems of certain safety-related pipe lines. The present Amended Application modifies the two previous applications to reflect additional support system redesign. The text of the requested modifications to the proposed Technical Specifications and a Safety Evaluation are attached to the amended application papers.


The present Application is amending two previous applications for which the filing fee required by 10CFR170.22 has been paid. Accordingly, no additional fee is required at this time.
