Pursuant to Section 50.90 of the Regulations of Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (Consolidated Edison), as holder of Facility Operating License No. DPR-26, hereby applies for amendment of the Technical Specifications contained in Appendix A to that license.

Specifically, we request that Technical Specifications 3.1.B and 4.2 be modified to update the Indian Point Unit No. 2 reactor vessel surveillance specimen removal program to be more consistent with the current ASTM E185-79 Standard. This Application is being submitted as committed in the Consolidated Edison letter dated September 24, 1980 from Mr. Peter Zarakas to Mr. Steven A. Varga (NRC).

The specific proposed Technical Specification revisions are set forth in Attachment A to this Application. A Safety Evaluation of the proposed changes is set forth in Attachment B to this Application. This

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evaluation demonstrates that the proposed changes do not involve a significant hazards consideration and will not cause any change in the types or an increase in the amounts of effluents or any change in the authorized power level of the facility.
