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

Dear Mr. Varga:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. transmits herewith three (3) signed originals and forty (40) copies of the document entitled "Application for Amendment to Operating License", sworn to on March 26, 1981. This Application requests an amendment to the Technical Specifications for Indian Point Unit No. 2 to effect revised limiting conditions for operation (LCOs) and surveillance requirements regarding leakage detection and removal systems for reactor coolant leakage and total leakage into the containment free volume. These revisions are being proposed in accordance with NRC's December 4, 1980 letter and Consolidated Edison's response dated January 5, 1981. The text of the requested modifications to the Technical Specifications and a Safety Evaluation are attached to the application papers.

In accordance with 10 CFR 170.22, this Application qualifies as a "Class III" Amendment. Accordingly, as required by 10 CFR 170.22, enclosed is a check in the amount of \$4,000.00 as the total filing fee for this Application. This payment is being made under protest, and Consolidated Edison reserves the right to challenge the validity of the imposition of these fees, and the basis for the determination of the amounts of the fees.
