Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Consolidated Edison") transmits herewith three (3) signed originals and forty (40) copies of a document entitled, "Application for Amendment to Operating License," sworn to on August 7, 1981. This Application requests an amendment to the Technical Specifications contained in Appendix A of Facility Operating License No. DPR-26.

The proposed changes, contained in Attachment A to the Application, would establish technical specification requirements for the Indian Point Unit No. 2 alternate shutdown system. These changes are being submitted as requested by Mr. D. Eisenhut's (NRC) February 20, 1981 letter and as committed in Consolidated Edison's May 19, 1981 letter to the NRC.
