APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO
OPERATING LICENSE

Pursuant to Section 50.90 of the Regulations of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC"), Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc., ("Consolidated Edison"), as holder of Facility Operating License No. DPR-26, hereby applies for amendment of the Technical Specifications contained in Appendix A of that license.


Specifically, it is requested that technical specification 4.14 be modified to incorporate requirements for appropriate equipment of the Indian Point Unit No. 2 alternate shutdown system. These proposed Technical Specification changes are being submitted in response to the February 20, 1981 letter from Mr. Eisenhut (NRC) and as committed in Consolidated Edison's May 19, 1981 letter to the NRC.

The specific proposed Technical Specification page revisions are set forth in Attachment A to this Application. A Safety Evaluation of the proposed changes is set forth in Attachment B to this Application. This evaluation demonstrates that the proposed changes do not represent


a significant hazards consideration and will not cause any change in the types or an increase in the amounts of effluents or any change in the authorized power level of the facility.
