
Dear Mr. Varga:

Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. transmits herewith three (3) signed originals and forty (40) copies of the document entitled "Application for Amendment to Operating License", sworn to on August 18, 1982. This Application requests an amendment to the Facility Operating License and the Technical Specifications for Indian Point Unit No. 2 to incorporate various requirements relative to steam generator examinations. These changes are being proposed in accordance with your May 15, 1981 letter. The text of the requested modifications and safety assessment are attached to the application papers.

In accordance with 10 CFR 170.22, this Application qualified as a "Class III" Amendment.
