Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Consolidated Edison") transmits herewith three (3) signed originals and forty (40) copies of a document entitled, "Application for Amendment to Operating License," sworn to on February 14, 1983. This application requests an amendment to the Technical Specifications for Indian Point Unit No. 2. The proposed Technical Specification changes, contained in Attachment A to this Application, are in response to NRC letter requests dated February 27, 1980, April 10, 1980, June 11, 1980, July 7, 1980, July 28, 1980, August 15, 1980 and June 1, 1982. These changes address such areas as overpressure protection, control of heavy loads, clarification of operability requirements, decay heat removal requirements during all modes of plant operation, upgrading of certain requirements in light of similar requirements contained in NRC's Standard Technical Specifications for Westinghouse PWR plants, fuel handling accidents inside containment and minimum water level above the reactor vessel during movement of control rods and fuel assemblies.

A more detailed listing of the areas impacted by the proposed changes is contained in the Safety Assessment provided as Attachment B to this Application. Upgraded requirements covering chloride detection and electrical system specifications as requested by NRC's July 7, 1980 letter are still under development. It is anticipated that proposed Technical Specification revisions covering these areas will be provided by July, 1983.

In accordance with 10 CFR 170.22, this Application qualifies as a "Class IV" amendment. Accordingly, as required by 10 CFR 170.22, enclosed is a check in


