However we contend that, even though NRC immediately extended the submission deadline from January 15 to January 31, 2010, forty-five days is not enough time for a reasonable assessment and a response especially since many of those days were during the year-end holidays.

We offer the fact that there are only seven respondents to date as evidence of the lack of proper public notification and opportunity for a timely response.
