Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. transmits herewith three (3) signed originals and forty (40) copies of the document entitled "Amendment No. 1 to Application for Amendment to Operating License", sworn to on June 29, 1984. This Application revises portions of Consolidated Edison's February 14, 1983 license amendment application for a change to the Indian Point Unit No. 2 Technical Specifications to: (1) specify the action required when a limiting condition for operation is exceeded and (2) clarify the applicability of the LCOs involved when either normal or emergency power sources for safety-related equipment are inoperable. The proposed changes are in response to a NRC request dated November 15, 1983. The text of the requested changes and a Safety Assessment justifying the changes and concluding that this amendment does not involve a significant hazards consideration are attached to the application papers.

The appropriate filing fee, in accordance with 10 CFR 170.22, was submitted by previous application dated February 14, 1983.
