APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO  
OPERATING LICENSE

Pursuant to Section 50.90 of the Regulations of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC"), Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Consolidated Edison"), as holder of Facility Operating License No. DPR-26, hereby applies for amendment of the Technical Specifications contained in Appendix A to that License. Specifically, Consolidated Edison requests that upon the completion of applicable backfitting procedures and requirements, the Indian Point Unit No. 2 Technical Specification 4.2 be revised to require augmented inservice inspection of the Indian Point Unit No. 2 reactor vessel during the next ten year inspection interval. This request is in response to an NRC letter dated October 16, 1984.



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a significant hazards consideration as defined in 10 CFR 50.92(c) and will not cause any change in the types, or an increase in the amounts of effluents, or any change in the authorized power level of the facility.


