As requested in your letters of December 31, 1984 and February 12, 1985, we are remitting with this letter a check in the amount of \$150.00 as the application fee for our June 29, 1984 and November 19, 1984 applications requesting relief from certain ASME Code requirements. As both these applications involve the same issue, we believe a single application fee is appropriate. Further, we note that the subject of our applications has been under NRC review for several years preceeding the recent changes to 10 CFR 170.12(c) and 170.21.
