APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO OPERATING LICENSE

Specifically, we request that the Technical Specification 3.3 Limiting Conditions for Operation (LCOs) for the Refueling Water Storage Tank (RWST) and the Spray Additive Tank be amended and that the Technical Specification 3.3 Basis for the RWST be amended.

The specific proposed Technical Specification revisions are set forth in Attachment I to this Application. A Safety Assessment for the proposed changes is set forth in Attachment II to this Application. This assessment demonstrates that the proposed changes do not represent any "Significant Hazards Consideration" as defined in 10 CFR 50.92(c).

As required by 10 CFR 50.91(b)(1), a copy of this application and our analysis concluding that the proposed changes do not constitute any "Significant Hazards Consideration" have been provided to the appropriate New York State official designated to receive such amendments. \prime
