
In accordance with 10 CFR Part 170 and Invoices Nos. H1395 and H1396 dated July 11, 1989, two electronic funds transfers in the amounts of \$54,177 and \$8,605, respectively, were tendered to the NRC on July 27, 1989 for the six-month period from July 1, 1988 through December 31, 1988.

The payments are for review of Part 50 applications for reactor license amendments, etc. and Part 55 services for replacement and requalification examinations respectively.

Concerning TAC No. 65747, by letter dated April 6, 1989 (attached), and in accordance with NRC staffs' request, Consolidated Edison withdrew its June 22, 1987 Application for License Amendment seeking revision of our steam generator tube inservice surveillance program to authorize sleeving as a repair technique. Since our application withdrawal was based upon a reversal of Commission policy in connection with acceptable tube sleeving methodology, our April 6 letter also requested that NRC credit our account for all fees and charges incurred which were associated with this application. To date we have not received a response to our request. We look forward to your prompt review and response to this matter so that we can accurately deduct the appropriate amounts, together with accumulated interest, from forthcoming Part 170 invoices.


This letter serves to notify you of our decision to withdraw the June 22, 1987 Application for License Amendment. The Application requested revision of our steam generator tube inservice surveillance program to authorize (but not require) sleeving as a repair technique.

The withdrawal was requested by your staff, citing the Commission's change in policy to no longer process applications such as this that do not refer to any particular methodology for sleeving (i.e., site-specific, vendor-specific analysis report).

Under these circumstances we plan to re-submit another application which will meet your new criteria. We request crediting to our account for all fees and charges incurred to date which are associated with this Application.
