
APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT
TO OPERATING LICENSE

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.90 of the Regulations of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission ("NRC"), Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. ("Consolidated Edison"), as holder of Facility Operating License No. DPR-26, hereby applies for amendment of the Technical Specifications contained in Appendix A of that license. Specifically, we request that Technical Specification 3.3.A.2.e, the action statement for the Boron Injection Tank flow path heat tracing, be deleted.

The proposed Technical Specification amendment is set forth in Attachment I to this Application. A safety assessment of the proposed amendment is set forth in Attachment II to this Application. This assessment demonstrates that the proposed change does not involve any "Significant Hazards Considerations" as defined in 10 CFR 50.92(c).


