

SUBJECT: IP2 Spent Fuel Pool Storage Capacity Increase (TAC 72962)

In letters dated June 20, 1989 and March 5, 1990 we submitted proposed revisions to the Indian Point Unit No. 2 Technical Specifications pertaining to spent fuel storage. Based on recent discussions between the NRC and my staff, we have retyped several of those pages (i.e., pages vii, 3.8-4, 3.8-5 and 3.8-6) to enhance their clarity and reflect the change in required decay time following shutdown (from 131 hours to 174 hours) which has been approved since our March 5, 1990 submittal. In addition, for clarity and consistency with Amendments No. 140 and 148, we have provided replacement pages for pages 3.8-2 and 3.8-3. No other changes have been made, and the safety assessment submitted with our application on June 20, 1989 remains unaffected and fully applicable. The replacement pages are attached.
