APPLICATION FOR AMENDMENT TO OPERATING LICENSE

Pursuant to 10 CFR 50.90 of the Regulations of the Nuclear Regulatory Commission (NRC), Consolidated Edison Company of New York, Inc. (Con Edison), as holder of Facility Operating License No. DPR-26, hereby applies for amendment of that license. Specifically, we request that Technical Specifications 3.3.E, 3.7.A, 3.7.D, 4.6.A and 4.6.B. and Technical Specification Basis 3.7 and 4.6 be amended to reflect changes made to the power feeds for the Component Cooling Pumps, increase the Emergency Diesel Generator (EDG) fuel oil minimum required storage and the EDG short term rating and to clarify the text with respect to the EDG nameplate rating, the tanks designated to store the 7 day minimum EDG fuel oil inventory, and the 138/345 kv feeds at the Buchanan Substation.

The specific proposed Technical Specification revisions are set forth in Attachment I to this Application. A Safety Assessment for the proposed changes is set forth in Attachment II to this Application. This assessment concludes that the proposed changes do not represent a "Significant Hazards Consideration" as defined in 10 CFR 50.92(c).

As required by 10 CFR 50.91(b)(1), a copy of this application and our concluding that the proposed changes do not constitute a analysis "Significant Hazards Consideration" have been provided to the appropriate New York State Official designated to receive such amendments.
