
As required by Amendment Number 40 to Facility Operating License DPR-26, we have performed the program of inspections of the steam generators as agreed upon by the Nuclear Regulatory Commission on May 15, 1979. The results of this inspection program and supplemental explorations are submitted as Attachments to this letter.

We request that the Commission's review of these results be available by August 31, 1979 to avoid delay in resuming power operation.

For the 1978 inspection program, we were advised by the Staff that, pursuant to 10 CFR 170.22, Commission review of the results of our steam generator inspection and issuance of the required license amendment had been classified as Class III and required a \$4,000.00 filing fee. Therefore, we have classified the 1979 inspection program report as Class III and a check for the required \$4,000.00 filing fee is being forwarded herewith. This payment is being made under protest and Con Edison reserves the right to challenge the validity of the imposition of these fees and the basis for the determination of the amounts of the fees.
