Dear Mr. Varga:

This is in response to NRC letters of March 5, 1980, and March 20, 1980 regarding Environmental Qualification of Electrical Equipment. Members of the NRC staff visited our corporate headquarters on March 26 and 27, 1980. Representatives of Con Edison, PASNY and Westinghouse discussed Environmental Qualification for Electrical Equipment with the NRC staff in Bethesda on April 3, 1980. Subsequent telephone conversations with your staff extended the date for the written submittal to May 9, 1980.

In the meetings with your staff our Emergency Procedures were provided and reviewed together with our submittal in response to I.E. Bulletin 79-01, and our qualification documentation. In response to the expedited review schedule established by the NRC for this program, Con Edison has obtained the assistance of Westinghouse, the NSSS vendor for Indian Point 2. An environmental qualification report for Indian Point 2 prepared by Westinghouse is attached. Because of the short period of time available to respond to our accelerated schedule, we are continuing our review to assure the completeness of our reply. It, therefore, may become necessary to revise or supplement the attached report prior to the site visit by your staff.

With regard to your letter of March 20, 1980, Note 6A applies to Indian Point 2. The information for Indian Point 2 pertaining to containment temperature and pressure conditions, requested by Enclosure 2, is contained in Chapter 14.3 of the FSAR and in current docketed LOCA analyses dated December 1978 and April 1980.
