Dear Mr. Varga:

This letter supplements an August 1, 1980 letter to you from William J. Cahill, Jr. regarding the Adequacy of Station Electric Distribution System Voltage.

Based on discussions between members of your staff and Con Edison Engineering personnel additional clarifications have been added.

We have agreed to install undervoltage relays on buses 2A, 3A, 5A, and 6A. These relays will be set at .86 per unit based on 460 volt (nominal voltage) with a time delay of 150 seconds.

With reference to the response to question 5 attached to the August 1, 1980 letter, we have agreed to accomplish this task by racking out the appropriate 6.9 kv circuit breaker rather than installing an electrical interlock.

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
