Your letter of February 11, 1981, received on February 17, 1981, transmitted the preliminary results of the staff's review of environmental qualification of safety-related electrical equipment of our facility, and requested within 10 days of receipt a statement supporting the safe operation of Indian Point Unit No. 2, that takes into account the NRC staff's preliminary list of potential equipment deficiencies.

We have reviewed the staff's identified potential deficiencies and our own ongoing environmental qualification reviews and we have determined that the potential equipment deficiencies have no impact on the continued safe operation of the plant.
