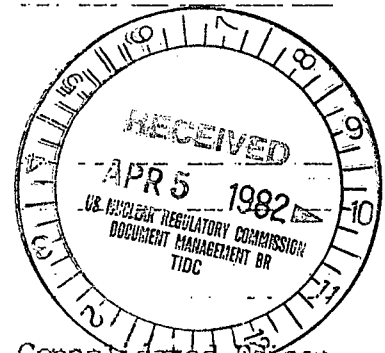


Dear Mr. Grier:
