RESPONSES TO NRC QUESTIONS
CONCERNING OPERATOR TRAINING

This responds to the six questions in the enclosure with the letter from Mr. Steven A. Varga to Mr. John D. O'Toole dated March 26, 1982.

RESPONSES TO QUESTIONS 1 AND 2

In questions 1 and 2 reference is made to enclosures 1, 2, 3 and 5 of Con Edison's "submittal letter." That is our letter from Mr Peter Zarakas to Mr. Harold Denton, dated September 19, 1980. The content of the lectures, referred to in question 1, is the same as indicated in enclosures 1, 2 and 3. The details of the lectures, referred to in question 2 are consistent with the outline, enclosure 5.

RESPONSE TO QUESTION 3

Lectures and quizzes on accident mitigation are given to operating personnel from the "plant manager" through the operations (Nuclear Power Generation Department) chain to the licensed operators and to the shift technical advisors in the Technical Support Department. Titles are:

General Manager, Nuclear Power Generation
Chief Operations Engineer
Senior Watch Supervisor
Senior Reactor Operators
Reactor Operators
Shift Technical Advisors

An organizational chart which illustrates the position of the above titles in the operations chain is shown in Section 6.0 of Appendix A, Technical Specifications (See figure 6.2.2)

A new General Manager has recently been assigned, his lectures and quizzes are scheduled to be completed by May 28, 1982.

RESPONSE TO QUESTIONS 4 AND 5

The responses to question 4 and the two questions in question 5 are affirmative.

RESPONSE TO QUESTION 6

Our requalification program satisfies the requirements of "item 2.e of enclosure 1 of the Denton letter of March 28, 1980."

In response to item II.B.4, the NRC has not previously specified that 80 contact hours of training is required. We have evaluated INPO's guidelines for material to be covered and have determined that this material could be adequately and accurately covered with 40 contact hours of instruction. This has been completed and is documented in each licensed individual's training folder. A copy of the outline has already been provided as enclosure 5 to our September 19, 1980 letter and has not been changed.

We note for your information that the submittal date of an earlier response that included the subject of training for mitigating core damage was February 26, 1981 not February 26, 1982.
